## CHILDREN'S RIGHTS AS SET OUT IN THE UN CONVENTION ON THE RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

Children have the right to have their dignity respected.

Children have the right to have a say in all issues concerning them.

Children have the right to play, to relax and to pursue artistic activities.

Children have the right to be protected from violence.

Children have the right to learn and to be supported in the development of their abilities.

Disabled children have the right to special care and support.

Children have the right to special protection if they are affected by war and if they are refugees.

Children have the right to obtain important information.

Children have the right to live healthily.

No child should be treated unfairly or discriminated against.
